

Notes to the 2021 accounts

The opening balance was £4402.61 and the closing balance £3792.59 giving a loss for the year of £621.15.

Income was largely from new members joining (£150) with expenses predominantly for the newsletter printing (£47.49) and postage (£248.18); the MAG affiliation fee (£100) and the public liability insurance (£356.49); website hosting was £24.

There was a small interest (£11.13) due from closing the Skipton BS account.

Few member financial benefits were given during the year other than one year's free membership. There were no free meals or charitable donations given away. No-cost events such as mid-week meets and runs were resumed as soon as restrictions were withdrawn.

The club remains in a healthy financial position with over one-year's funds held in account.

Issues to consider at the AGM for approval are:

1. Approval of the accounts
2. Approval of the member subscription for 2022; Proposed is £13 for member, £6 for family member; ie no change.
3. To approve the re-opening of a Paypal account to allow payment of subscriptions online (payment by BACS was added during 2021)
4. To agree a reduced fee of £10 for new members joining after 1st July; renewals would not be eligible for this concession.
5. To agree to continue the concession for those joining from 1st Oct to extend membership to 31st Dec the following year. (This is helpful for practical reasons as members begin to renew before the end of the year)
6. To agree the donation of £100 to Macmillan Cancer Support; this being the amount raised at the last Skittles Evening.
